Block Assembly:

Throw	Twin	Queen
16 block	24 blocks	64 blocks

Begin by assembling the 9-patch at center of block. Add addition pieces, first adding the single pieces, then adding the strip sections.

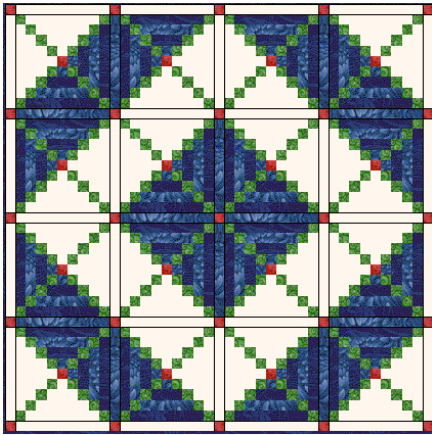


Quilt Assembly:

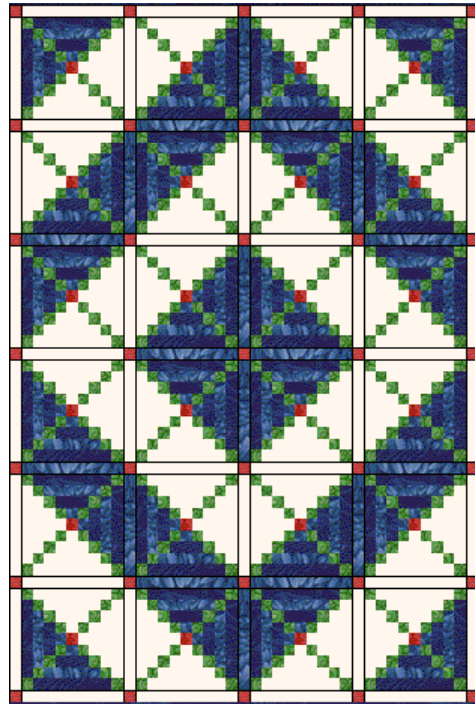
Using the diagrams below, assemble sashing strips, cornerstones, and blocks accordingly.

Vertical Columns	4	6	8

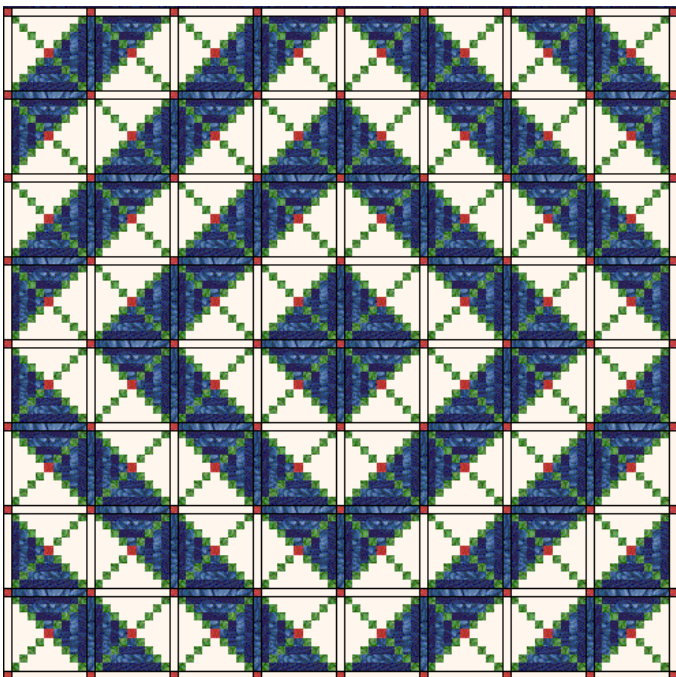

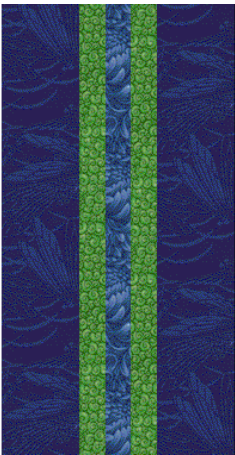

Add Borders:

Borders are cut straight-of-grain (along selvage edge). Measurements assume mitered corners.

	4 strips 1 1/2" wide	65 inches long	85 inches long	105 inches long



Assemble borders as shown at left. Sew to quilt, mitering corners using your preferred method.

Square corners are also an option, attaching long sides first, then short sides, continuing through each individual border.
